Through State statute 13-6-1(E) NMSA 1978, the New Mexico State Agency for Surplus Property (NMSASP), formerly the Federal Property Assistance Bureau is given the right of first refusal when disposing of obsolete, worn-out or unusable tangible personal property of any State Agency. Thank you for complying with this statute by giving the NMSASP notice of the property you wish to dispose of.
