Subject: Disposal of Tangible Personal Property Albuquerque, New Mexico

Through State statute 13-6-1(E) NMSA 1978, the New Mexico State Agency for Surplus Property (NMSASP), formerly the Federal Property Assistance Bureau is given the right of first refusal when disposing of obsolete, worn-out or unusable tangible personal property of any State Agency. Thank you for complying with this statute by giving the NMSASP notice of the property you wish to dispose of. The NMSASP has viewed your email request from November 13, 2023 and has decided to refuse property. We are basing this decision on the fact that the property is either old or in poor condition.
